My name is Jacqueline "Jacqui" Broering. I have taken on the position of Activities Director and Edgewater Director at Celina Manor. I am a St. Henry High School grad and continue to reside in St. Henry with my husband. I am a Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant and you may have seen me around the building prior to this position. I have practiced clinically as an OTA at Celina Manor for nearly four years prior to taking on this new role in October of 2017.



I am very excited to take on this role, and have lots goals and ideas to allow for further development of our memory care unit, Edgewater. We

have received a grant with a program called The Gift of Purpose. This grant has allowed not only myself, but our social worker, Erica Luthman, to become certified in the completion of the Reality Comprehension Clock Test (RCCT). The RCCT allows us to complete an assessment with our residents whom we see signs of dementia or Alzheimer's so that we may form a baseline of their current cognitive status and continue to monitor as dementia may progress. This is a great tool, as it also allows me to educate the staff members on possible approaches to take while caring for each resident in an individualized manner.

I am looking forward to developing our new Activity programming for dementia and Alzheimer's care, utilizing the Gift of Purpose method to allow for each resident in need of memory care to have individualized plans to help maintain their current cognitive functioning for as long as possible. I am excited to see the continued development of our memory

This month's employee spotlight is Justine Gonzalez!


